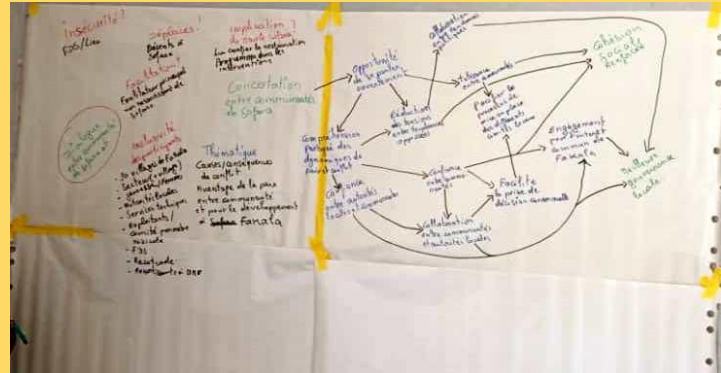

The period from July to September 2023 was marked by several events within IMRAP.

First, by the shrinking size of the team with the end of the 5P Canada and Cooperation Switzerland projects. Secondly, with the launch of phase 2 of the "Vestibule of Peace" project. On the institutional side, IMRAP saw the appointment of Mr. Djibril Diallo as Chairman of the Board of Directors.

On the other hand, the general context of the country is marked by the clarification of MINUSMA's withdrawal from Mali. This leads us to note an upsurge in attacks against the symbols of the State, but also against peaceful populations by armed groups unfavourable to peace. Thus, from July to September 2023, several attacks were carried out by armed groups opposed to peace, the most recent of which are: the attack on the Timbuktu boat, the attack on the Bourem military camp, the shelling targeting the Timbuktu airport area, the attack on the Léré military camp, etc.
