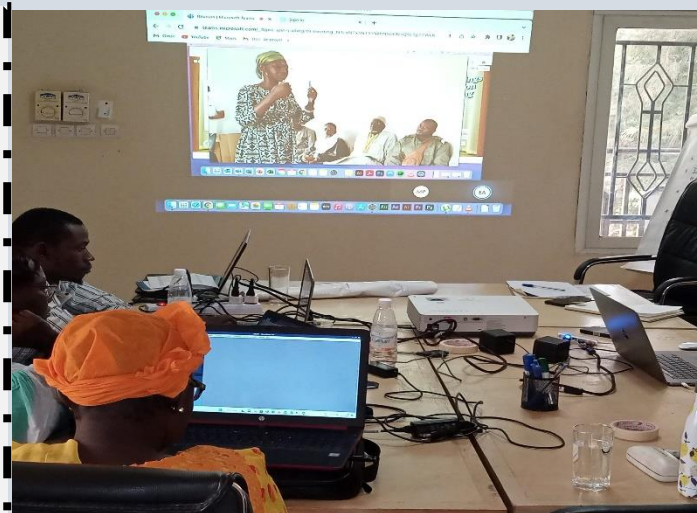

BAMAKO

The closing workshop of the project activities: "Integrated approach to fight impunity and for improved access to justice in Central Mali" was held from 06 to 07 December 2022 at the INTERPEACE premises in Bamako.

One of the objectives of this participatory action research was to understand the perceptions and experiences of litigants and justice actors on the challenges of access to justice, the causes of impunity as well as the opportunities for better improvement in the circles of Mopti, Djenné, Bandiagara, Ségou, San and Niono in Central Mali. The team from the Malian Institute for Research Action for Peace (IMRAP) conducted consultations (homogeneous and heterogeneous) and quantitative surveys through the participatory barometer tool among the population as well as institutional actors and traditional authorities to collect and analyze data.

The purpose of this closing workshop was to better understand the process of project implementation and to assess the individual changes that have taken place among the actors of the judicial chain, traditional authorities and populations. Success stories, key results, identification of success factors and challenges in the project implementation approach, project management, collaboration and country context were identified and analysed. Thus, lessons learned and what will be the future action points in the next steps, were presented during this workshop.

Bamako:

A training workshop for internally displaced persons, IDPs of the district of Bamako in first aid and fire safety, from 15 to 16 December 2022 at the National School of Civil Protection, located in Sogoniko

To promote contact and build trust between the SDF and displaced persons and local populations, the implementation of a training session in first aid and fire safety and awareness sessions remains essential in order to reduce the gap between them in favor of better collaboration. To this end, the General Directorate of Civil Protection has decided to organize with the support of partners (IMRAP/Interpeace) a training in first aid gestures. Advice can also be provided to IDPs, especially those who are regularly victims of fires, in order to mitigate the risk of fires occurring.

Thus, this training will strengthen ties and give IDPs the opportunity to place more trust in the State through the Security Forces, particularly the Civil Protection. It will also allow them to acquire the knowledge necessary for the proper execution of first aid gestures. And these gestures are intended to preserve the physical integrity of a victim, before the arrival of organized help. With the notions of first aid and fire safety, the internally displaced people of Bamako will know how to react in the event of an emergency. They will be able to perform appropriate gestures on their sites as well as during domestic and traffic accidents such as clearing airways, smothering fire, preventing further accidents, managing drowning, dressing wounds, cardiac massage, lateral safety position, handling of defences and firefighting

According to the Executive Director of IMRAP, Mr. Alassane NIAMBELE:

"This training gives IDPs the opportunity to place more trust in the State through the Security Forces, particularly the Civil Protection. But it also allows them to acquire the knowledge necessary for the proper execution of first aid gestures intended to preserve physical integrity, or even life, before the arrival of the emergency services."
