Experience-sharing workshop between the action research groups (GRA) of the Kangaba Circle, and those of Djenné from 18 to 23 July 2022

Also the opportunity was good for the participants from Djenné to visit the sacred places of Kangaba such as: kouroukanfouga, sacred hut, white hill, and vestibule of kaniogo.
