- Contribute to the supply of drinking water to the police station in the spirit of bringing more efficiency to the work of the officers in the performance of their missions but above all to strengthen social ties and trust between the population and the police station through the use of boreholes by the community
- The borehole will serve the needs of the local population who will come to obtain drinking water. This could help break the ice and thus create collaborative links between police officers and the population, especially women and young people, and thus establish the maximum conditions for the implementation of community policing in Djenné.
- Facilitate the integration of elements of the Police Station into the community to reduce feelings of mistrust.
- Create/strengthen collaboration between the population, especially women, youth and the police


Support the implementation of the community initiatives of the Traditional Dances Forum and the Interschool Competition for the Prevention of Violent Extremism in Schools
